<p>Point Loma, CA</p> <p>The Famosa Slough is a 37-acre wetland between Ocean Beach and the San Diego Sports Arena area. The channel portion of the slough extends from West Point Loma Boulevard, northward, to the San Diego River Channel. The slough is flushed with salt water from the river channel, and also collects rainwater from the surrounding neighborhood. The 12-acre channel portion and the 25-acre southern portion of the slough are owned and maintained by the city of San Diego. Regular work parties are the second Saturday of odd numbered months.
